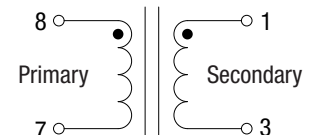
Mechanical Dimensions

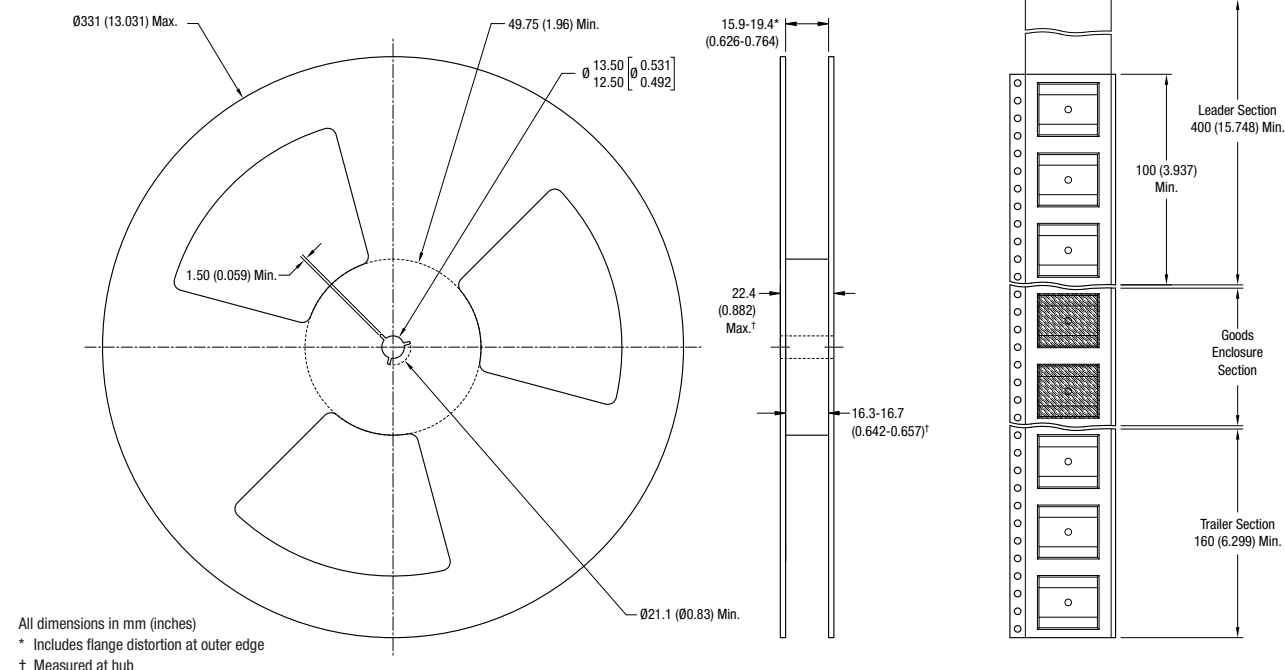

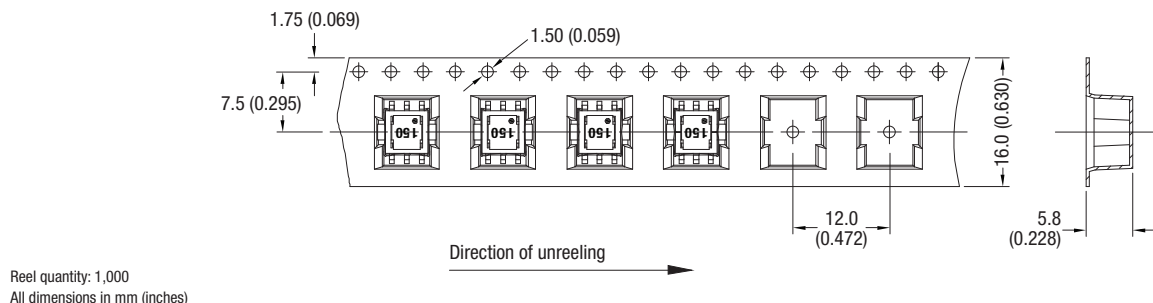
