#### **Description**



# **Loading Instructions**




Start tape roll over top outer flange (A) of hub as shown to dispense tape adhesive side down. Press down on roll to fully mount on hub.




Thread end of tape through narrow guide slot (B). To dispense the tape, hold the dispenser as shown and pull the leading edge of the tape from the roll. Allow the roll to rotate freely on the dispenser.


# **Operating Instructions**



Apply approximately 2-1/2 inches or 65 mm of tape to the side of the carton.



Pull the dispenser across the carton seam, apply pressure to the tape roll to provide tension on the tape web to obtain a tight seal. Buff the tape down with the opposite hand as shown.



Continue the tape web down the side of the carton about 2-1/2 inches or 65 mm To cut the tape, push down and rotate the dispenser slightly. Buff the tape down by hand.

### **How To Replace the Blade**

A

CAUTION – Use care when working near the blade as the blade is sharp.

- Loosen, but do not remove screws and nuts to remove used blade.
- Install replacement blade with beveled cutting edge toward tape roll.
- Seat blade on screws and center on blade clamp.
- Tighten mounting screws and nuts to secure blade.
