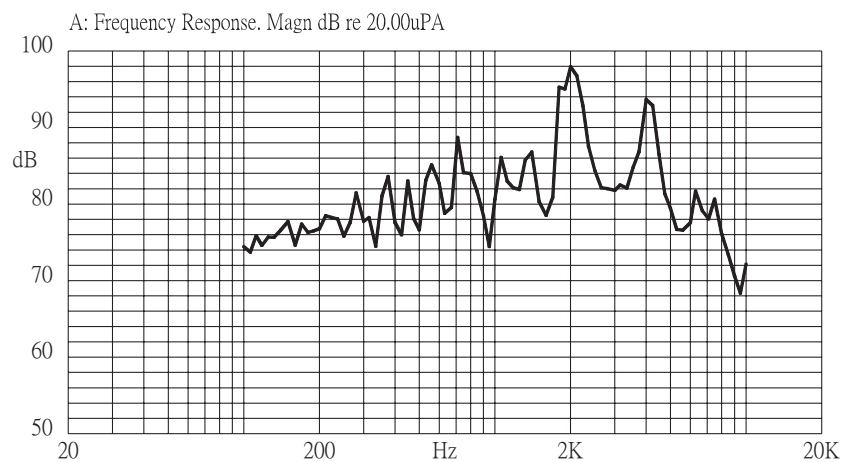

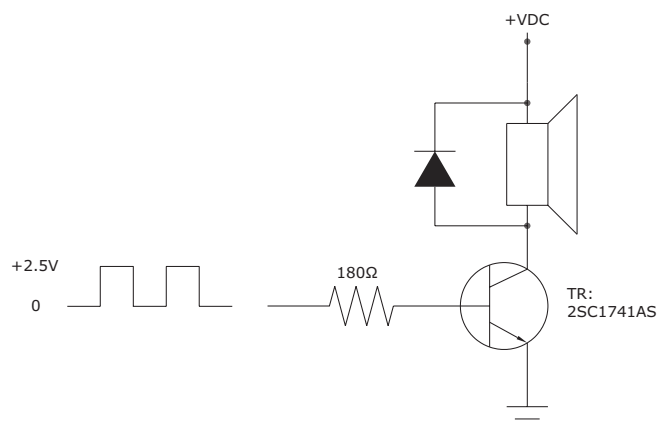

FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE



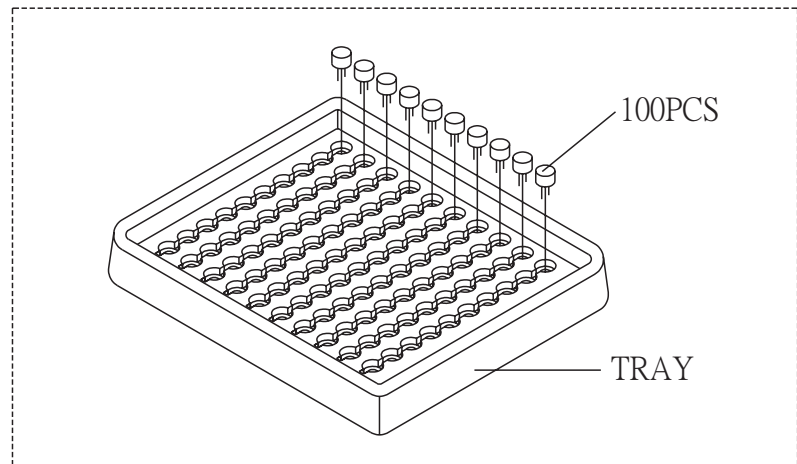

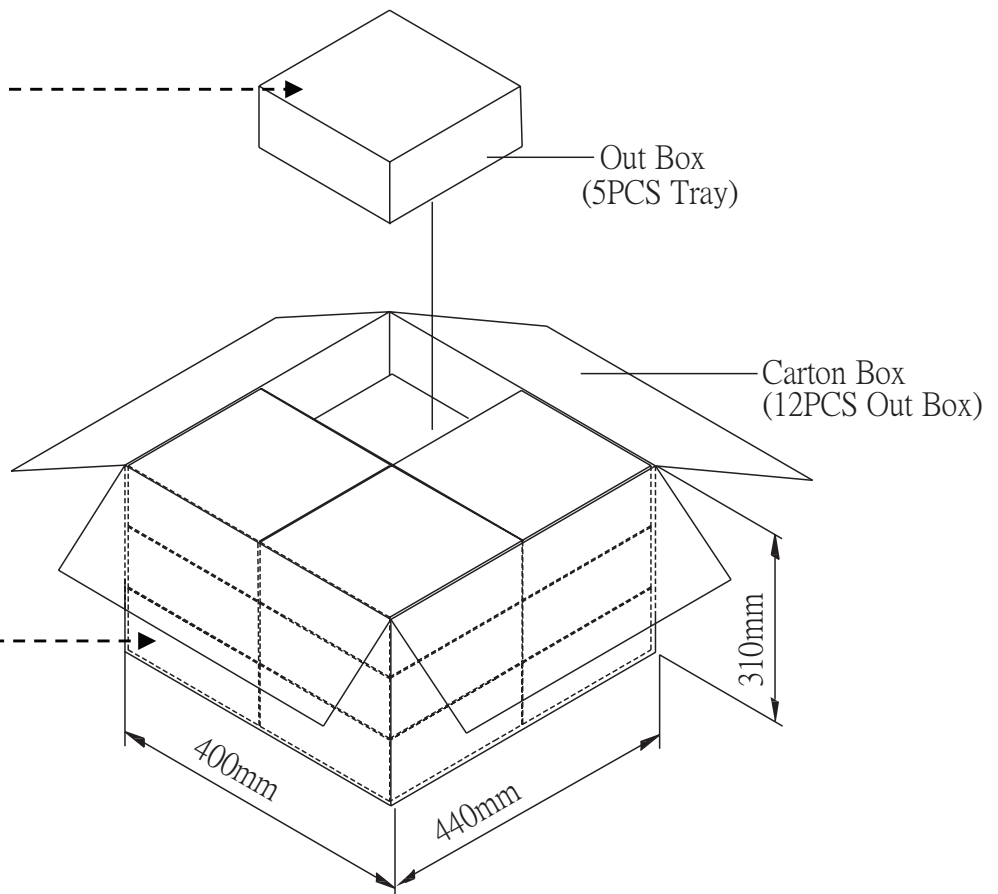
