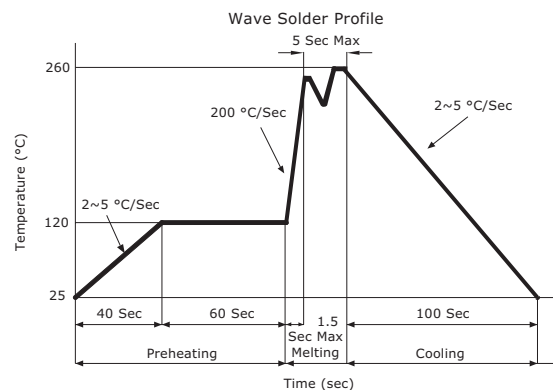

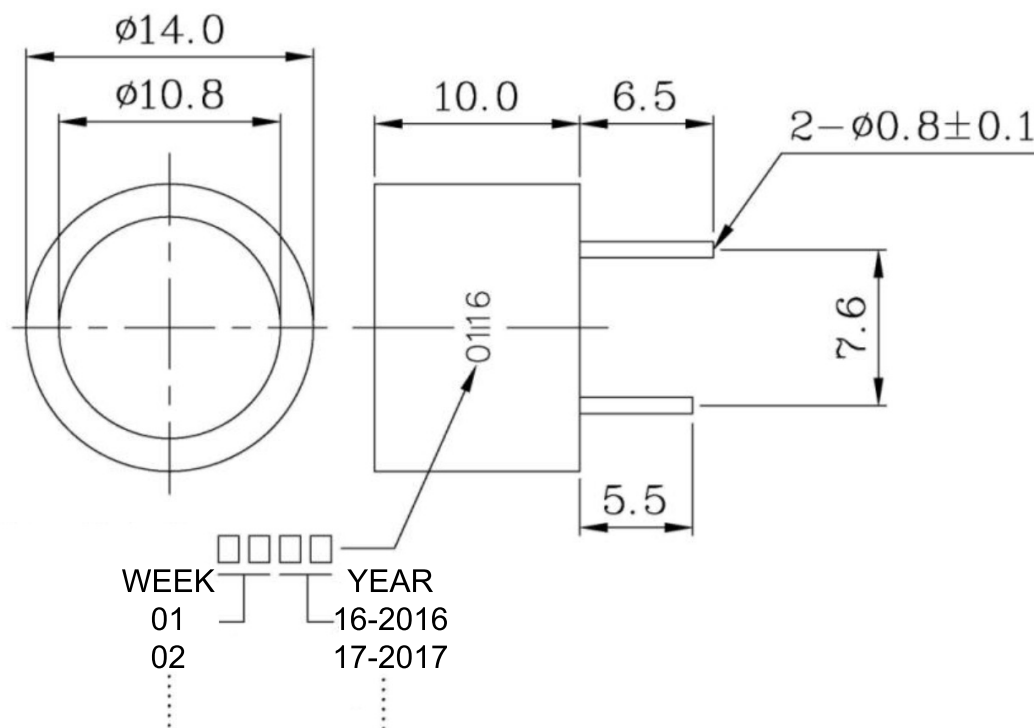

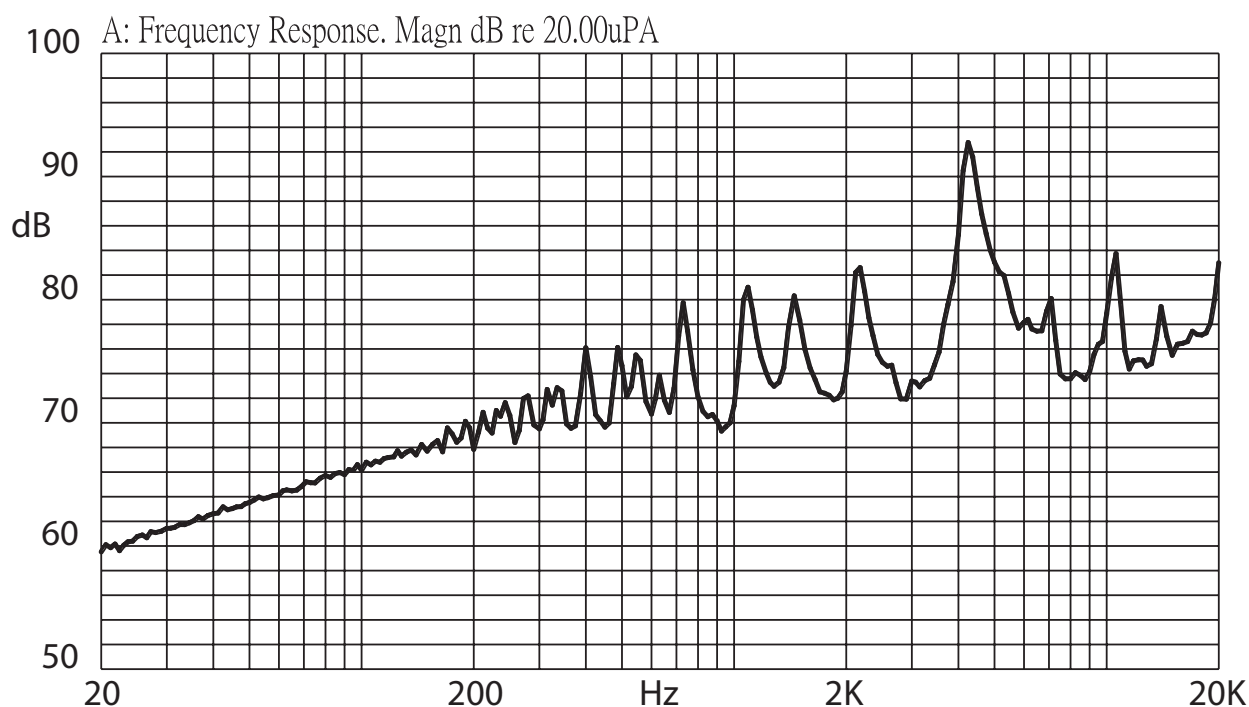

FREQUENCY RESPONSE CURVE



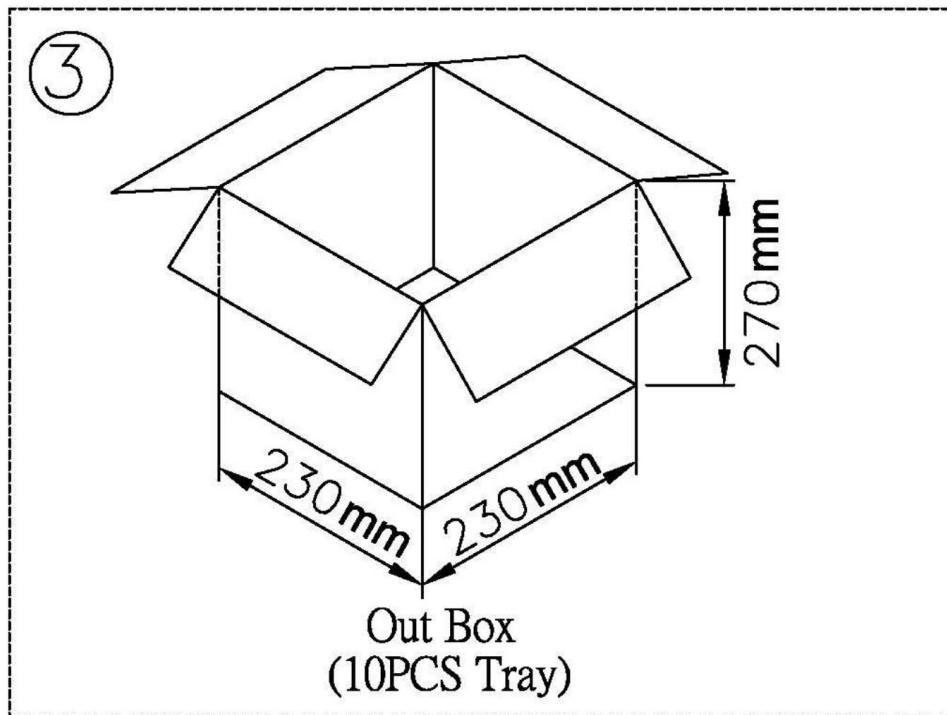
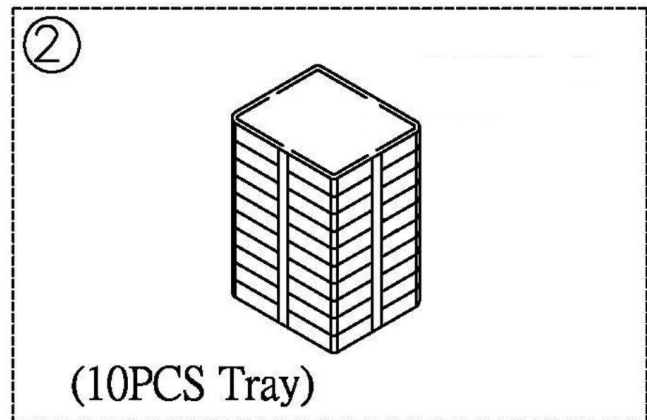
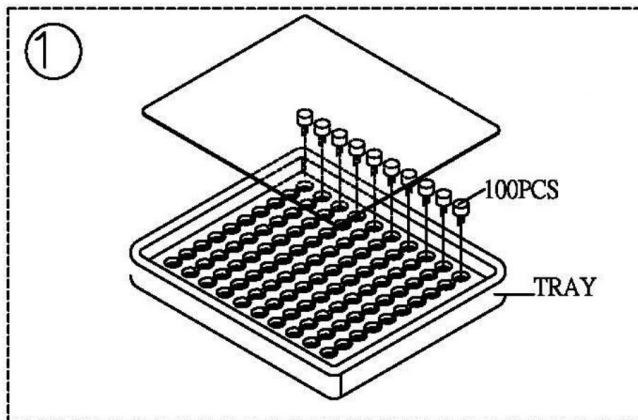
