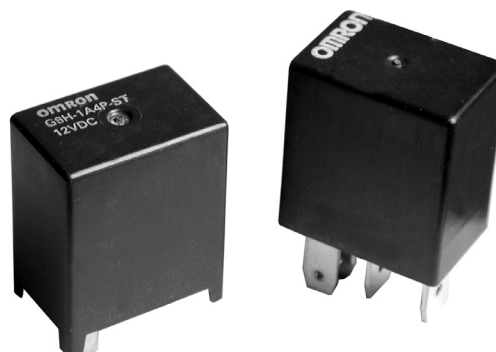

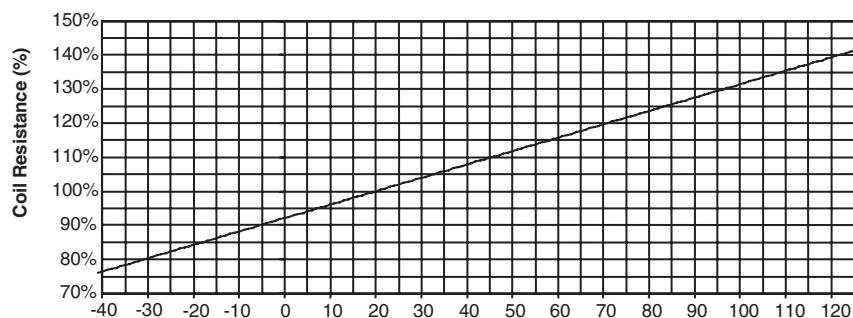

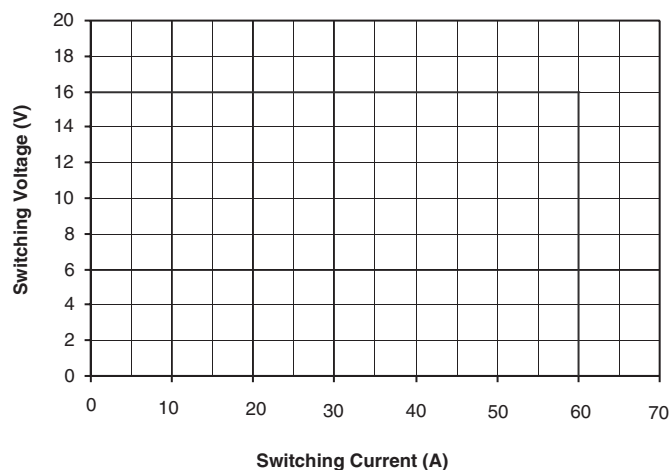

Normalized Coil Resistance vs. Temperature (20° C reference)

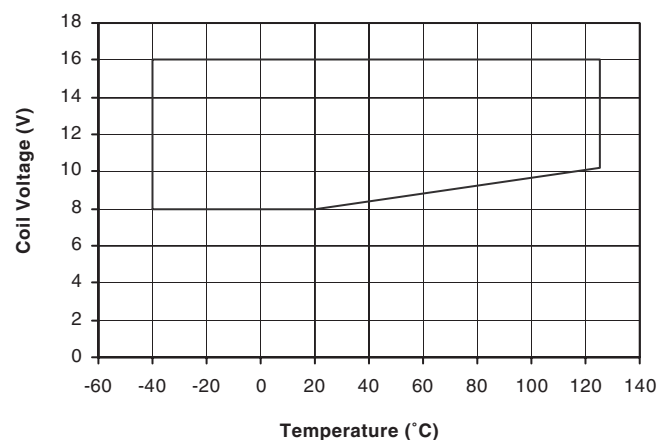


Example: Resistance of 100 Ω coil

Load Limit Curve



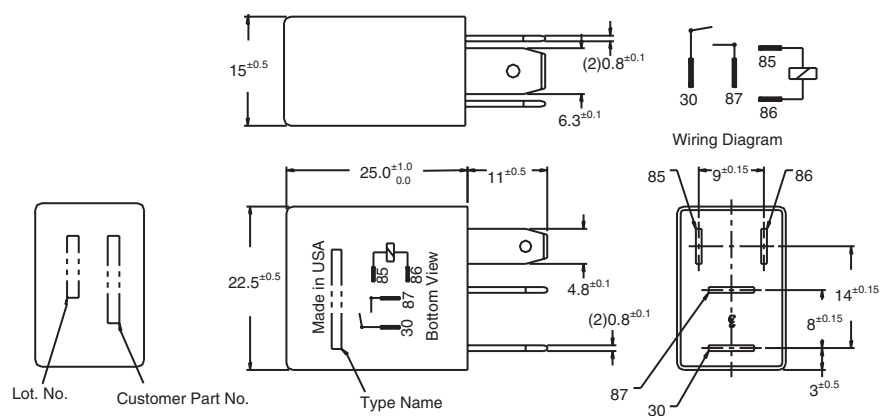
Operating Voltage Range (100 Ω coil)



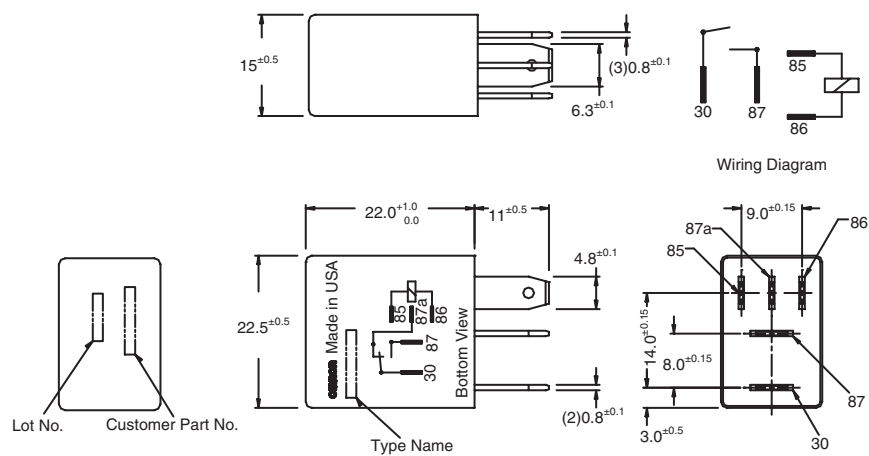

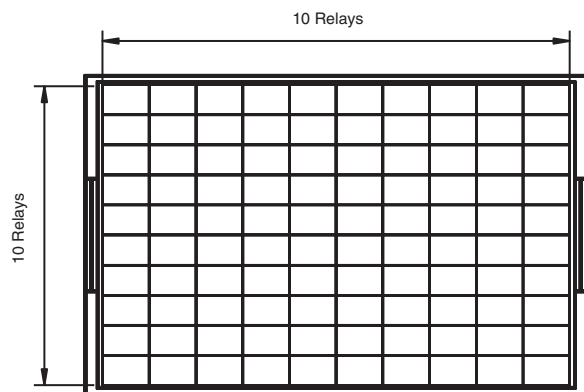
