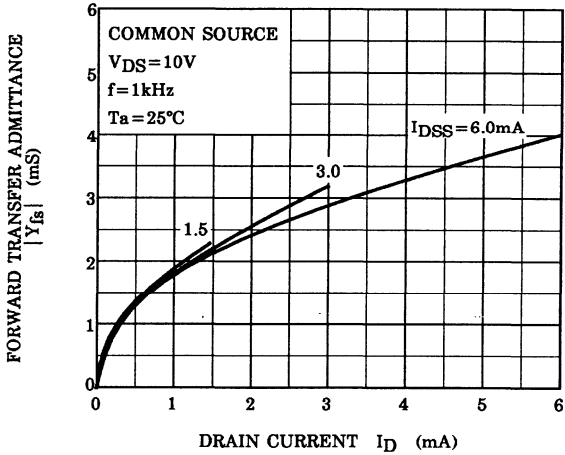
$I_D - V_{GS}$



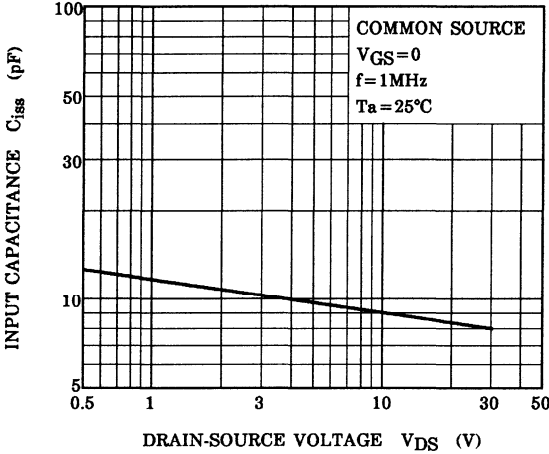
$I_D - V_{DS}$ (LOW VOLTAGE REGION)



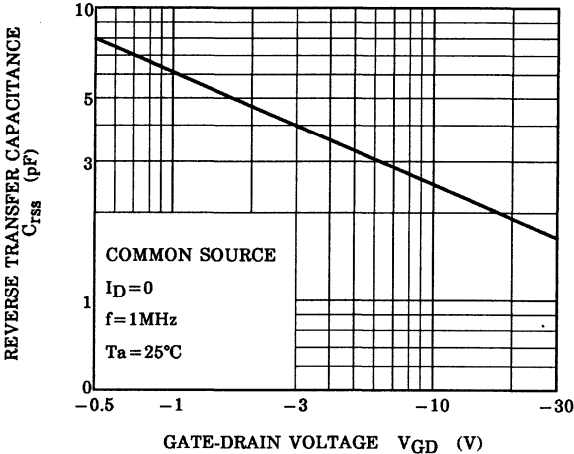

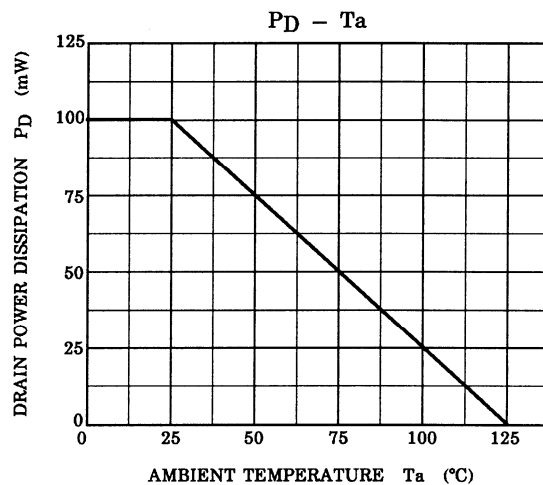
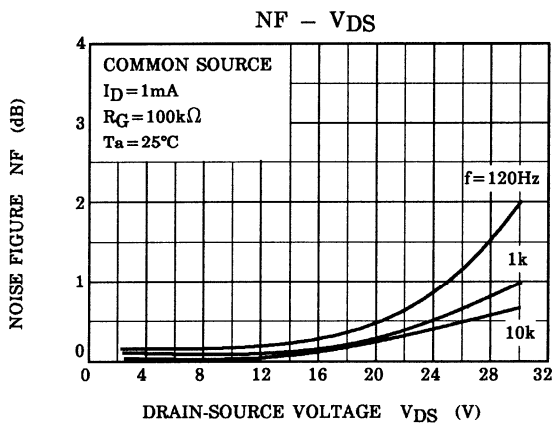
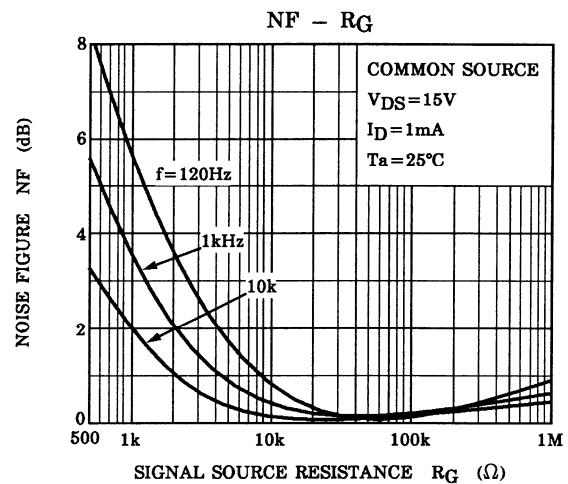
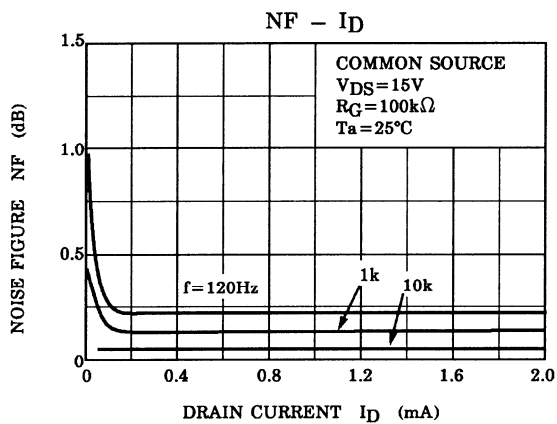
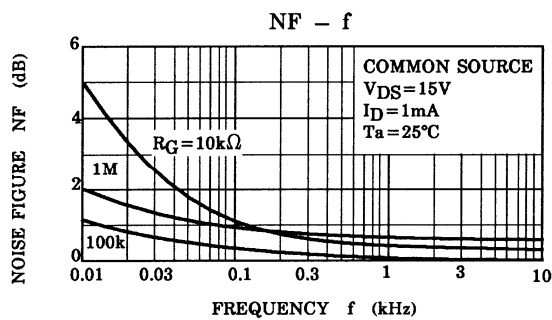
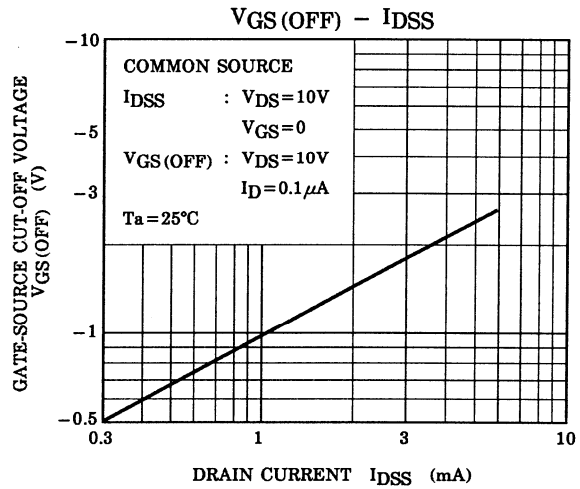
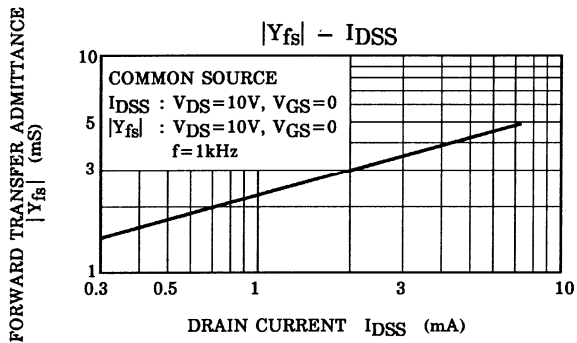


$C_{iss} - V_{DS}$
